

Ebook Central: Downloading Books for Offline Use




This guide explains how to download books and chapters so you can access them without an internet connection.



Full Book Download

1. Make sure you have **Adobe Digital Editions** downloaded on your device – a free program that is different than Adobe Reader. If you're using a mobile device, the Adobe Digital Editions app is free from the Apple App Store and Google Play.
2. **Sign into your institution's Ebook Central account.**
3. **Search and click on the ebook you want to download.**
4. **Click on "Download Book"** on the book detail page. **Select the number of days** you wish to download the book for. Depending on your institution's settings, you may be required to open the book before downloading it. If the ebook does not need to open, you will receive a pop-up to download the full ebook.
